Dear Copeland parents,

All CFISD students now have the opportunity to borrow a district-provided Chromebook and/or a Kajeet hotspot. The Kajeet hotspot will allow your student to connect to the internet from either the district-provided Chromebook or a personally owned device. Kajeet is the leading filtered internet service in the nation and will monitor and filter your student's access to the internet. Chromebooks and/or Kajeet hotspots will be checked out to students as needed to complete assignments or work on projects. Below are the expectations Copeland and CFISD have for the use of these devices:

- Students will check out devices (using parent request form) from the library and return devices the following morning upon arrival at school.
- The devices **MUST** be stored in the accompanying tote bag/case when not in use.
- Students will not eat nor drink when utilizing the device at home.
- Parents/Students will report any problems with either device to the librarian as soon as possible.
- If a student takes home a Kajeet hotspot, other family members may connect their personal devices to it. However, all access will be highly filtered and monitored.
- Students may not lend the devices to other students or family members.
